RULES OF THE RANGE

Note: By submitting your signed application for membership you are acknowledging that you have read, understand and agree to these rules.

1. No consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages is allowed on the property.
2. No smoking on the property except in designated areas. None of these designated areas are located on the tournament course.
3. The combination to the gate may not be given to anyone.
4. No firearms allowed on the range (except hand drawn bows).
5. No broad heads may be used except in designated areas.
6. No hunting is allowed on the property.
7. No overnight camping is allowed on the property.
8. No illegal activities are allowed on the property.
9. All members and guests must sign the Guest Agreement prior to participating in 3D shoots.
10. The gate must be closed at all times (unless a tournament is in progress).
11. No containers or trash (including cigarette butts) will be left on the range: please use the trash cans.
12. Vehicles must remain in designated parking areas. If special transportation provisions need to be made, please consult an acting officer.
13. All minors on the property must be in the presence and active oversight of a responsible adult.
14. No trees will be cut, removed, or impacted in any way without specific written permission from the Lessor.
15. Violation of any of these Range Rules may be grounds for your removal from the range and/or revocation of your Membership.
16. No Crossbow on the course or practice range. (At this time we are researching the use of crossbow on our range, but are not prepared to have them on the range safely. Please bear with us while we continue to look in to this matter.)

HCB reserves the right to alter and/or amend the Range Rules at any point during the membership year.
